Dear Parent,

School districts are required by state regulation to have and distribute suggested safe walking routes for every elementary school. These routes are developed, based upon traffic patterns, existing traffic controls, and other crossing protection aids, such as school crossing patrols. The number of school crossings are to be limited so that students are encouraged to cross in groups and so that traffic gets used to specific crossing spots by students.

Crossing guards are located at NW 119th and NW 28th at the Thomas Jefferson driveway, NW 119th and NW 26th, and on NW 26th at the Felida driveway. There is no longer a crossing guard at NW 119th St. and 31st Ave.

Attached for your use is our school's safe crossing map that shows the suggested walking and crossing points. I would suggest that you review this information with your child and, if you are new to our school, or if your child is young and will be walking to school, that you actually take the time to walk the route with him/her.
